Summary:

A total 09 industry interferences were reported in June, 2023. Notable among these we identified that, 'Banayan' will distribute 50 lakh forest, fruit and medicinal tree seedlings across the country on occasion on World Environment Day 2023. On the others hand a discussion meeting was held on the issue of printing new packet prices for cigarette products in the head office meeting room of the Department of Consumer Protection where British American Tobacco Company representative, Japan Tobacco Company representative was present.

With the technical assistance of the Union, WBB Trust has collected all the information and prepared a brief report about the interferences done by the tobacco companies.
